## **Directions for use of this Worksheet**

The purpose of this worksheet is to assist in gathering the information needed to complete the SAGE Award nomination.

■ The SAGE Award is a Special Award for Great Efforts and is presented to the oldest (in age) active patroller in the Registration Unit, Section, Region and Division.

This award is to recognize and acknowledge the dedication of the recipient and act as an inspiration and example for others to follow.

If qualifications for a SAGE award are:

- The nominee has at least three years of continuous active service in any classification and is currently active in actual "on hill" patrol duty.
- The nominee is the oldest (age wise) in that particular Registration Unit, Section, Region, or Division.
- The minimum age for this award is 50 years old.
- This award can only be received once by an individual and is retained until someone else is nominated who is older or if the individual no longer meets the qualifications.

A letter of nomination should be sent to the Region Awards who will confirm with the Section Chief and if applicable the Region Director, and Division Director.

The nomination letter must include the nominee's name, birth date, classification, and registration unit.

Requests for the certificates can be made through the Region Awards Advisor who should have the certificates in inventory.
