Directions for use of this Worksheet

The purpose of this worksheet is to assist in gathering the information needed to complete the Western Region Outstanding Service Award (WROS) nomination.

• The WROS award is intended for patrollers of the local patrol who have served their patrol in some capacity where this service does not warrant the level of a Yellow Merit Star.

Service to the local patrol can be defined as but not limited to:

- Teaching the OEC to Basic candidates, as the Instructor of Record or one who contributed greatly to the success of the class
- Teaching the Intro to Patrolling or Hill Training for Basic Candidates
- Instructor of Record for the Fall OEC Refresher
- Instructor of Record for annual Hill Refresher
- Assisting the Patrol Representative as Assistant Patrol Representative
- Coordinating an event which benefits the Patrol or Region such Awards Banquet
- Organizing and conducting Senior OEC training or Senior Hill Training for the local patrol.
- More than one patroller per patrol may receive this award each season. It is left to the discretion of the Patrol Representative to not abuse this privilege. The Western Region Awards Committee reviews and approves these nominations and will not approve the nominations if abuse is suspected.

Sections 1-3 - Nominees Information and Signatures

The nominees contact information and Patrol registration should be filled out accurately. Use the Patrollers name as it is registered in the National database. **Do not use nicknames**.

The appropriate Approval names and Signatures list the correct hierarchy. The only exception is when nominee holds one of these positions. In this case print Nominee in the appropriate field.

Section 4 – Certificate Wording

Give reason, event, place, and dates, indicating exactly how the wording on the award certificate should appear. Be brief, as space on the certificate is limited to 3 centered lines. The National Office reserves the right to change the wording.

DO NOT LEAVE THIS AREA BLANK!

Be brief but to the point such as "In recognition and acknowledgement for being the Candidate Hill Training Captain for Any Ski Area."

Section 5 – Sponsor's Recommendation

All nominations must include the Sponsor's recommendation.

The sponsor should describe what the patroller did to warrant the nomination. A narrative of the patrollers actions which the sponsor believes warrant the WROS recognition. Do not include extraneous information. What is important is what the patroller did.

Describe the reasons, event, place, and dates, indicating exactly what the patroller did to deserve this recognition.

The sponsor is typically the Patrol Representative, in the event the sponsor is not, then the Patrol Representative must also sign the original nomination form indicating they support the nomination.
