Senior Ski/Ride Examiner	Certification (one time)	By Division Staff	By Division Staff
	Recalibration (every 3 years)	By Division Staff	By Region Staff (trained each year)*
Senior Toboggan Examiner	Certification (one time)	By Region Staff	By Division Staff
	Recalibration (every 3 years)	By Region Staff	By Region Staff (trained each year)*

* Recalibration by Region Staff Requires:

- Region Level Recalibration will be led by calibrator who participated in the most recent year ASDW.
- The calibrators will be a minimum of: currently active PSIA/AASI Level 2 for Ski/Ride, and an IT for Toboggan.
- The region level calibration clinic must be held separately from the region senior test.
- The calibration must include at least one calibrator from another region for quality assurance purposes.
