Critical Standard: Does the candidate safely & efficiently control the toboggan to the accident site?

Performance Objectives:

1. Appropriate route selection & approach to scene
2. Safe, expedient, controlled and consistent speed
3. Smooth and rounded turns
4. Balanced, stable and proper position
5. Effective transitions
6. Minimal slipping and bouncing of toboggan
7. Performs controlled emergency stop if asked
8. Effective recovery technique if needed

Performance grading scale:

(+) Exceeds Objectives (=) Meets Objectives (-) Fails Objectives

Unloaded: More to Most Difficult Smooth or Moguled Terrain:(+) (=) (-)

Critical Standard: Is the toboggan run smooth, controlled, efficient and safe?

Performance Objectives:

1. Appropriate route selection & safe departure
2. Ride is smooth and comfortable
3. Safe, expedient, controlled & consistent speed
4. Balanced, stable and proper position
5. Demonstrate appropriate use of chain brake
6. Controls direction of toboggan
7. Brakes toboggan as needed
8. Effective communication with tail operator
9. Executes transitions with stability and control
10. Controls edges during traverse with minimal sideslip

Performance grading scale:

(+) Exceeds Objectives (=) Meets Objectives (-) Fails Objectives

Lead Alone (with secondary brake):Most Difficult Smooth: (+) (=) (-)

Skill: LOADED TOBOGGAN-REAR

Critical Standard: Does the rear operator safely and effectively control the toboggan as needed?

Performance Objectives:

1. Traverses left and right with minimal slipping of toboggan
2. Brakes toboggan as need with effective edging and pressure
3. Safe, expedient, controlled & consistent speed
4. Smooth and controlled turns and transitions
5. Generally coordinates change of direction with front operator
6. Maintains rear of toboggan in stable position
7. Controls rope in the fall line from a stable position
8. Adapts to terrain and condition changes
9. Maintains safe distance from the toboggan
10. Monitors the condition of the patient

Performance grading scale:
