

## **Directions for use of this Worksheet**

The purpose of this worksheet is to assist in gathering the information needed to complete the BRAVO Award nomination.

- The BRAVO in the award title stands for: The Best Record of Activity in a Volunteer Organization.

This award is an annual recognition to the patroller with the most hours of on-hill, patrol room duty at each ski area and can include OEC Instruction hours.

This award is usually presented at the Patrol level, but can be presented at the Section level.

If presented at the Section level:

- It is at the discretion of the Section Chief.
- A letter of nomination should be sent to the Region Awards Advisor, including the nominee's name, the Registration Unit, and the total hours of duty.
- The Region Awards Advisor will confirm acceptance of the award from the Section Chief.

Requests for the certificates can be made through the Region Awards Advisor who should have the certificates in inventory.
